Conveniently located at the junction of U.S. 23 and M-14, and minutes from downtown Ann Arbor, this landmark complex is home to some of Michigan's most prominent companies, along with numerous professional firms, nonprofits and fast-growing entrepreneurial businesses.

Our rolling, 271-acre campus is the site for one of the most distinctive Class-A office buildings, detailed with impressive architectural finishes and appointments. The tone of life at Domino's Farms is set by the classic "Prairie"-style design, with its linear configuration and signature copper roof—inspired by the great American architect, Frank Lloyd Wright. The sophisticated design is complimented by sunflower-strewn fields, grazing cattle, and a resident herd of American bison. All these elements combine to create an atmosphere that enhances the image of our more than fifty tenants and boosts employee morale and productivity for the nearly three thousand individuals who work in the building.

Domino's Farms Office Park opened its first phase in December 1985. Over the next twenty years, five additional phases were added bringing the building size to nearly one million square feet.
